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## 1 □ Proposal for Phase Four

Over the past three years, the public awareness on mercury has been improved greatly by GVB's various educational activities. At present, it is important for GVB to let public pay more attention on certain mercury issues, After the investigation on Chinese mercury-free thermometers and sphygmomanometers last year, mercury in hospitals has come into our mind, which is very close to our health, GVB will continue to make a depth involvement in domestic mercury issues in medical devices to promote healthcare without mercury.

**The major works of Phase Four:** a comparative analysis on quality control certifications apply to measuring devices in health care for both mercury and non-mercury devices, such as thermometers and sphygmomanometers; market survey on mercury and non-mercury measuring devices, including identify the large international donors and domestic purchasers of health care in China, etc; Besides two research above, Mercury exhibition and educational activities will be conducted in six different cities.

These goals can be further broken-down into 4 objectives as following. To accomplish these objectives, tangible actions are listed in the following form of **Major Activities and Key Deliverables**, in which, related objectives and evaluating indicators are clearly stated. As a result, we envision that China's NGOs will be able to identify their focuses of work on mercury and form consensus of national and international strategy on mercury in health care.

### **Objectives**

1. Maintain and expand the Chinese mercury network and improve NGOs' capacity on mercury
2. Let knowledge and information about mercury continued to be disseminated to different areas in China
3. Improve GVB's professional capacity on dealing with the mercury issues in the health care.
4. Inform Chinese people and Administrations about the mercury strategy and policy at Global level
