Here: regulations on trading mercury in Singapore?

Dear Madam / Sir,

I'd like to inform you about the insolvency proceeding over the assets of the company DELA 6mbH. By the order of the Insolvency Court in Bielefeld (GERMANY) the insolvency proceeding has been opened on July 1rst 2014. The sole right to trade or sell assets of DELA 6mbH is therefore transferred to me as insolvency Administrator.

The Assets of the company include 81.282 tons of metallic Mercury (Hg) stored safely in Jurong Port, Singapore (2.356 flasks on 95 pallets). This material probably comes from the chlor-alkali industry and has been shipped to Singapore against the regulations of the European Union. Before selling this material, I have to verify, whether there are any regulations / restrictions in Singapore similar to those in the European Union:

Regulation (EC) No. 1102/2008 of the European Parliament an of the Council of 22 October 2008 on the banning of exports of metallic mercury and certain mercury compounds and mixtures and the safe storage of metallic mercury:

"Article 2

From 15 March 2011, the following shall be considered as waste and be disposed of in accordance with Directive 2006/12/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2006 on waste in a way that is safe for human health and the environment:

(a) metallic mercury that is no longer used in the chlor-alkali industry (...)"
